### From the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 14:21-27)

After Paul and Barnabas had proclaimed the good news to that city and made a considerable number of disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch. They strengthened the spirits of the disciples and exhorted them to persevere in the faith, saying, "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." They appointed elders for them in each church and, with prayer and fasting, commended them to the Lord in whom they had put their faith. Then they traveled through Pisidia and reached Pamphylia. 

The children of St. Jerome school will be celebrate May Crowning of the Blessed Virgin Mary at the School Mass on Friday May 20th during the 8am Mass.

During the month of May, we honor the Virgin Mary in special ways in our devotions and prayers, especially in the praying the mysteries of the Holy Rosary.

By the way, **Mark's funeral will be on Saturday, June 11th at 11am at St. Jerome's Church.**

For the record, I have had years with more funerals. Our responses to covid have created for some people barriers to receiving not only the sacraments of baptism and matrimony, but also confession and communion. Many families seem to have postponed getting married in church and getting their children baptized. I pray that people not get so caught up in what has become a habit or distracted by the busyness of life that they omit these life giving sacraments given by Christ as avenues of grace.

"Father, isn't a Spiritual Communion good enough?"

I will admit that doing a Spiritual Communion is OK when the possibility for receiving Eucharist is not available. Yet to choose a Spiritual Communion over receiving the REAL PRESENCE of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, does NOT fulfill His command to take and eat as well as DOING THIS in memory of Him.

Speaking of grace and Christ's REAL PRESENCE, we need prayer warriors to intercede for church, nation and the world during Eucharistic Adoration. In particular, our 11am to 12:30pm time period needs additional support as the Blessed Sacrament during Adoration is not to be left unattended. The Lord invites us to watch and pray with Him. If you can give some or all of this time in prayer it would be a blessing. See Kathy for details or to sign up for adoration. Thank you.


