Trunk or Treat is fast approaching. (Friday, October 24th) I will admit that the tamales being sold that evening definitely have my attention.

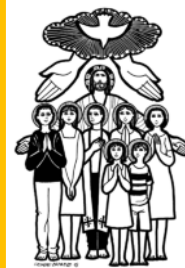

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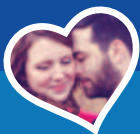
