From the Gospel according to Luke

(Lk 10:1-12, 17-20)

At that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way. Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him; but if not, it will return to you. Stay in the same house and eat and drink what is offered to you, for the laborer deserves his payment. Do not move about from one house to another. Whatever town you enter and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God is at hand for you.' Whatever town you enter and they do not receive you, go out into the streets and say, 'The dust of your town that clings to our feet, even that we shake off against you.' Yet know this: the kingdom of God is at hand. I tell you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom on that day than for that town."

Fr. Bill's Musings

July 9th is the anniversary of Augustus Tolton's passing from this world. You might not know that on June 12, 2019 Pope Francis declared Rev. Augustus Tolton, the first known black Roman Catholic priest in the United States, to be "venerable" advancing the former slave's cause in recognizing him as a saint. Previously a commission was established to investigate Good Father Gus' life, writings and teachings. Witnesses had been interviewed and testimony gathered. On February 24, 2011, the commission investigating Augustus Tolton's life found that his life and example was worthy of imitation and he was declared "Servant of God."

Venerable Augustus Tolton needs two more miracles to confirm his sainthood. With one, you are declared "Venerable"; with the second, you are "Blessed" and with the third, you are proclaimed a saint.

Regarding miracles, "For the cure to be considered miraculous, the disease must be serious and impossible (or at least very difficult) to cure by human means and not be in a stage at which it is liable to disappear shortly by itself. No medical treatment must have been given, or it must be certain that the treatment given has no reference to the cure. The healing must be spontaneous." In most cases healings are not verified as a miracle. For example, the Lourdes Medical Commission since 1883 has validated only 70 of the over 8,000 cures they have investigated. It is not that amazing things aren't happening but other factors (not miraculous) can explain most of them.

Rev. A. Gerard Jordan of Springfield, Illinois is the person advocating on behalf of Tolton's canonization. It is his job to help prove Augustus Tolton is a saint. "We've received reports of hundreds of favors, things that can't be explained," Fr. Jordan said. "Out of those hundreds, two of them we've verified to be, through medical science, unexplainable, so those are the two we've turned in so far."

"There's a lesson for everyone in Tolton's life: something for white and black, woman and man, Catholic and non-Catholic and that the examples he set of perseverance in the face of hatred and intolerance, bridging of cultural divides and staying true to one's self and vocation are still relevant today."

Please continue to ask for Venerable Augustus Tolton's prayers and intercession in your life. We need more saints and I know it is past time for one of these to be an African American Catholic. Your requests through him can help make this happen.
