From the book of Exodus (Ex 32:7-11, 13-14)

The LORD said to Moses, "Go down at once to your people, whom you brought out of the land of Egypt, for they have become depraved. They have soon turned aside from the way I pointed out to them, making for themselves a molten calf and worshiping it, sacrificing to it and crying out, 'This is your God, O Israel, who brought you out of the land of Egypt!' Fr. Bill's Musings

I know our children need God, community as well as faith and hope these days, perhaps more than ever. I know that Catholic Faith is an essential part to answering these challenges... and I know St. Jerome School can help our children in these areas. Yet, I need your help.

Our St. Jerome School is growing. Our enrollment is the highest it's been to begin the school year in the last 6 years. While we are doing everything we can to bring families in and give their children a wonderful Catholic education we still have some families who are struggling financially and need assistance. We also have needs in our school that we would greatly appreciate help with such as our fundraising opportunities like our "Run 4 Bucks" happening this month.

How can you help?:

TUITION ASSISTANCE: We have about 20 families in need. Your monthly donation would greatly help them meet their goals. We will also gladly accept one-time donations. Last year, I and a few others helped make possible a good education for our children whose families truly needed our help.

TEACHER WISH LISTS: We have amazing teachers who have been instrumental in making the school a success and keeping it going year after year. Like teachers everywhere, they have used their personal funds to purchase classroom items for the children and have not updated their own needs.

PLEASE LET THE TEACHER ORDER THESE SO WE DON'T END UP WITH 500 tricycles. We are seeking donations to provide for these wishes.

Our middle school math/science teacher mentioned that he would love to get Kesler's Science subscription for the year (\$300). "It has cool activities and engaging videos to enhance our program."

Our pre-k teacher would like 2 or 3 tricycles for the kids to use at recess and break.

Our T-k teacher would like 5 sets of washable markers (\$5 each) as well as craft and collage materials.

Our kindergarten teacher is interested in games for hot and rainy days: Connect 4 (\$9) and Candyland (\$12). She is also looking for erasable markers for whiteboards (10 sets).

Our first grade teacher would like a set of scholastic books (\$60) for the classroom.

Our second grade teacher would like to establish a classroom library with books at their reading level.

Our art teacher would like 25 #8 brushes for painting. She would also like of permanent colored sharpie markers (\$10 a set). She is also interested in classic art posters for her room's environment.

Our third grade teacher would like 15 multiplication "wrap-ups" (\$12 each)

Our fourth grade teacher would like 15 Catholic Children's Bibles from St. Mary's Press (\$32 each).

Our fifth grade teacher would like a kidney shaped desk for working with her kids in the classroom (about \$400)

Our extended daycare teacher would like snacks and small water bottles for the children.
