Beloved: First of all, I ask that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for everyone, for kings and for all in authority, that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion and dignity. This is good and pleasing to God our savior, who wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. For there is one God. There is also one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as ransom for all. This was the testimony at the proper time. For this I was appointed preacher and apostle — I am speaking the truth, I am not lying —, teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth. It is my wish, then, that in every place the men should pray, lifting up holy hands, without anger or argument. The word of the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**

about you? Prepare a full account of your stewardship, because you can no longer be my steward.' The steward said to himself, 'What shall I do, now that my master is taking the position of steward away from me? I am not strong enough to dig and I am ashamed to beg. I know what I shall do so that, when I am removed from the stewardship, they may welcome me into their homes.' He called in his master's debtors one by one. To the first he said, 'How much do you owe my master?' He replied, 'One hundred measures of olive oil.' He said to him, 'Here is your promissory note. Sit down and quickly write one for fifty.' Then to another the steward said, 'And you, how much do you owe?' He replied, 'One hundred kors of wheat.' The steward said to him, 'Here is your promissory note; write one for eighty.' And the master commended that dishonest steward for acting prudently. "For the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. I tell you, make friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so that when it fails, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings.

The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones; and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones. If, therefore, you are not trustworthy with dishonest wealth, who will trust you with true wealth? If you are not trustworthy with what belongs to another, who will give you what is yours? No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon."

Fr. Bill's Musings

I am grateful to Fr. Roy for sharing his insights on dealing with troubling times. I pray that we can hold onto the truth that God loves us: All I ask of you is forever to remember me, loving you.

Our school's grandparents day rocked. The Friday morning mass was like Easter Sunday full. Some of those present mentioned it was their first in-person mass since covid. On Sunday one family greeted me by telling me, "We're back!"

If Catholics truly believed in Christ's real presence in the Eucharist, they would take every opportunity to partake of the bread from heaven. I guess some don't recognize this precious gift we are not worthy to have, but are commanded to take and eat. Those of us who do recognize the gift are challenged to testify by our actions and words, especially by how we treat one another. If His real presence doesn't help us to stay centered on Christ, His peace, His patience, His forgiveness and love... then how can those who don't understand, come to truly believe? "See how they love one another" is the sign of His real presence. I need to live it better.

The fence repair is in process. Evidently these are good times for those in security businesses. We are told it will take one day... but we know not the day nor the hour.

Next Sunday we will be celebrating Catechetical Sunday at all the masses. We will be praying for, as well as blessing all teachers. The Lord knows our young people need good shepherds.

If you would like to make a general donation to our school to be used wherever most needed you can do so by cash or check and just let us know so we can direct as needed.






