


# St. Jerome Church

1. All religious services are allowed to take place indoors without capacity limitations, social distancing, and/or pre-arranged "reservation" systems.
2. Parishes can open for prayer group meetings, ministerial gatherings, and social gatherings provided that sensible public health precautions are observed. (With cleaning and summer weather, August appears to be our goal for these re-openings.)
3. Masks are not required for fully vaccinated individuals outdoors or indoors for religious services. **Non-vaccinated people are asked to wear masks indoors.**
4. Volunteers "working" at mass will be required to wear masks when working in the church.
5. Hand sanitation must be available for all visitors.
6. Liturgical singing can take place.
7. Communion will only be under the form of bread. Communion on the hand is strongly encouraged but communion on the tongue is now permitted.
8. Liturgical processions may resume
9. Holy Water will be available in the vestibule. Bring your own container for your personal use.
10. **The Communion Procession will begin from the front rows** and will proceed toward the back to avoid the need to turn around and see when you row will go.
