#### From the book of Isaiah

(Is 6:1-2a, 3-8)

In the year King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a high and lofty throne, with the train of his garment filling the temple. Seraphim were stationed above.

They cried one to the other, "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts! All the earth is filled with his glory!" At the sound of that cry, the frame of the door shook and the house was filled with smoke.

Then I said, "Woe is me, I am doomed! For I am a man of unclean lips, living among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"

Then one of the seraphim flew to me, holding an ember that he had taken with tongs from the altar. He touched my mouth with it, and said, "See, now that this has touched your lips, your wickedness is removed, your sin purged." Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?" "Here I am," I said; "send me!"

#### From the first letter to the Corinthians (1 Cor 15:1-11)

I am reminding you, brothers and sisters, of the gospel I preached to you, which you indeed received and in which you also stand. Through it you are also being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you, unless you believed in vain. For I handed on to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures; that he was buried; that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures; that he appeared to Cephas, then to the Twelve. After that, Christ appeared to more than five hundred brothers at once, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

After that he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one born abnormally, he appeared to me. For I am the least of the apostles, not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me has not been ineffective. Indeed, I have toiled harder than all of them; not I, however, but the grace of God that is with me. Therefore, whether it be I or they, so we preach and so you believed.

(Lk 5:1-11)

While the crowd was pressing in on Jesus and listening to the word of God, he was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret. He saw two boats there alongside the lake; the fishermen had disembarked and were washing their nets. Getting into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, he asked him to put out a short distance from the shore. Then he sat down and taught the crowds from the boat. After he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish and their nets were tearing. They signaled to their partners in the other boat to come to help them. They came and filled both boats so that the boats were in danger of sinking. When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at the knees of Jesus and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." For astonishment at the catch of fish they had made seized him and all those with him, and likewise James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners of Simon. Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." When they brought their boats to the shore, they left everything and followed him.

## Fr. Bill's Musings

On the front cover of today's bulletin we have the pictures of six African-Americans whose cause for being formally recognized as saints by the Roman Catholic Church are in process. Please note that this process begins with a formal investigation of their life to see if they did live saintly lives, worthy of imitation. After they have been found to be good role models, the next steps toward "canonization" depend upon miracles done through their intercession. For miracles to be recognized, it must be shown that it occurred through the intercession (prayers) of this candidate for sainthood. This means these six need people to ask for their intercession and prayers for healing. For some saints this has taken as few as few as 50 years and for others, more than 300 years. But if no one asks for their assistance, their process can not move ahead.

If you or someone you love is in need of healing please consider letting one of these six saints in waiting assist them in their healing and recovery. After all, the saints of God are before His throne making intercession for people. Use them and help make them better known.

- 1) **Mother Mary Lang** is a nun in Baltimore who ran a school for Black children during the era of slavery.
- 2) **Pierre Toussaint** is a Haitian-American and former slave who went on to becoming a successful businessman and philanthropist in New York.

3) **Thea Bowman** is a Mississippi-born scholar and evangelist.

4) **Reverend Augustus Tolton** is a former slave who in 1886 became the first Black priest in the U.S.A.

5) **Julia Greenly** is a former slave who became known as Denver's "Angel of Charity" for her work on behalf of that city's poor.

6) **Sister Henriette DeLille** is a Black nun born in 1813 from New Orleans who opened the first Catholic Senior Citizen's Home and also founded an order of women religious.
