From the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 1:1-11)

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

When they had gathered together they asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" He answered them, "It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven."

We are grateful to **Rev. James T. Bretzke, S.J.** for sharing his gift of priesthood with us these last months at our Sunday Liturgies. His semester at LMU has come to an end. He will be returning to his assignment in Ohio. Please do keep him and all our Jesuit brothers in prayer as they continue to share the good news of the gospel.

Next, two years of "Media Mass is Good Enough" and "Spiritual Communion is Good Enough" has resulted in some well-intentioned Catholics developing new patterns and habits that they find more convenient and easier to work with in their busy Sundays. In many churches Sunday mass attendance has not returned to pre-covid levels. Some healthy people who think nothing of going to a baseball game or a concert, have not yet returned to physical attendance at mass. The importance of actually receiving communion seems to have been forgotten by many who choose to believe they are being faithful.

I understand that for the homebound and sick these "On-line" options are excellent ways to stay connected with the church and our Lord. My own mom who is approaching her 90th birthday participates at our 8am Zoom Masses each day. The eucharistic minister from her own parish usually arrives with communion around our own communion time on Sunday morning. My mom knows, as well as her community knows, the importance of receiving the real, REAL thing: the Eucharist.

The Bishops of the United States are establishing a **National Eucharistic Revival** to help our hearts be on fire in receiving the Eucharist which will begin this summer and continue through 2024.

The mission of the revival is to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. This revival seeks to establish a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission "for the life of the world."

I hope all the faithful appreciate that in the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. The whole Christ is truly present -- body, blood, soul, and divinity -- under the appearances of bread and wine, the glorified Christ who rose from the dead. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist.

We are asked to remember that the Lord Jesus, on the night before he suffered on the cross, shared one last meal with his disciples. During this meal our Savior instituted the sacrament of his Body and Blood. He did this in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the Cross throughout the ages and to entrust to the Church a memorial of his death and resurrection.

In this precious sacrifice Jesus gives himself to us in the Eucharist as spiritual nourishment because he loves us. By eating the Body and drinking the Blood of Christ in the Eucharist, we become united to the person of Christ through his humanity. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (Jn 6:56). In being united to the humanity of Christ, we are at the same time united to his divinity. Our mortal and corruptible natures are transformed by being joined to the source of life.

Please don't take His presence for granted. We need to be united with Him.

To help us all grow in this area, the archdiocese has announced **The Archdiocesan Eucharistic Congress to be held on Saturday, August 13, 2022 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels.**

Have a blessed weekend and at least for me, **Sunday is incomplete without receiving Him.**


