Fr. Bill's Musings



Thank you. I am humbled and honored by the kindness and love you have shown me. I give thanks to God for His bringing us together here at St. Jerome. Thank you for your prayers, words of encouragement and gifts on my birthday. May God bless you!

I love mass. I love the Eucharist. Eucharist is not just a thing. Eucharist is a person. It is a relationship. It is a transforming commitment. We become what we consume as our flesh and blood are united with His. St. Clare of Assisi explains it this way: "We become what we love and who we love shapes what we become. If we love things we become a thing. If we love nothing, we become nothing. Imitation is not a literal mimicking of Christ, rather it means becoming the image of the beloved, an image disclosed through transformation." What I love shapes who I become.

At communion I literally become one with Him. At communion I am made one with all who partake of His Flesh and His Blood. WE are united in HIM: One Lord, One Faith and One Baptism. AS we receive we make a commitment to be one with Him, that is, to accept His forgiveness, love and mercy, and to share His forgiveness, love and mercy. This is a life-long way of loving. This project is not complete until I am truly one with our Lord in heaven.

We all are in need of transformation. As we become more united with Him, the fruit we bear is transformed from bitter and dividing to sweet and uniting: a "Common Union of Love," aka. Communion. This is why we receive His Word, break open the scriptures and ponder HIS WAY. We dwell, study and pray and hopefully work on putting into action (becoming what we love) what we are receiving. In baptism, confirmation and communion I am now His. I am becoming His body for the Life of the world.

The first weekend of May our children will be receiving their first communion. On Sunday, May 5th, Bishop Clark will be with us to confirm our teens and three adults. Please note that they learn from what we do and how we treat each other. We are His Body. I pray that they, and we recognize the transforming wound marks of Jesus we each bear. And continue to love, forgive and show mercy as He has loved, forgiven and shown mercy to us.
